MEMBERSHIP CONTRACT

called here and further **WCHSA**,

was signed the contract for membership and partnership as follows:

I. COMMON PARTS

WCHSA presents itself as an organization with noncommercial registration, the main goal of which is the development of the worldwide cynology and the improvement of the dog breeds levels worldwide while preserving and developing further their working abilities and improving the physical and psychical health of the separate specimens and the breeds populations as

whole, consists of: a) the selection of the best specimens for the exterior and the breeding but also on the use of hunting trials and contests, and all the utility sports with dogs. In the same time it propagates applications especially concerning dogs and champions or raising the cynology with the practical application of the contemporary human needs for their companionship quality and for utility dogs, etc. Part of WCHSA's work is the consolidation and popularization of the breeds and breed groups and the work with newly formed contemporary breeds and varieties of existing breeds.

Mainly to work in all above-mentioned fields WCHSA has as its goal the preservation of the clean cynology, humanism and adherence to practicality, efficiency and friendliness, sportsmanship and the Olympic ideals. The same goals and interests it sets against its members and it selects partners with the same interests.

WCHSA serves the role of an international alliance of national level noncommercial registered organizations and is the main controlling organ for those organizations who are granted both full or associated membership in WCHSA, and acts as a coordinator and registrar for the registries of the international championships, international and multi-champions, kennel name holders, judges – national and international ranked in all divisions, instructors, trainers and lecturers in all divisions and disciplines in the system of WCHSA, it sets and coordinates the calendar plan and the changes of the plan for the expositions, examinations, trials, competitions, seminars and all other internationally ranked cynological events to be held under the aegis and with the knowledge of WCHSA. All the activities of WCHSA are held in consistence with the international laws, concerning the cynology and the zootechnics, hunt, sports and dog assistance as a whole, and also in consistence with the European Union Directives (as WCHSA is initially registered and based in EU).

As an international alliance of national organizations with noncommercial registration, WCHSA obliges itself to fulfill all its functions in shortest possible time, with least possible slowdowns and with maximum transparency. It stands against monopoly in such areas as pedigreed canine breeding, organized hunt assisted with dogs and all sports with dogs, and also for mutual recognition and honor between all cynological organizations around the world, and for equality in their work. Members of WCHSA can be organizations (officially registered) with different size and activities range; the membership in WCHSA is voluntary and does not require payments of any affiliation or membership fees.

The WCHSA membership may be full or limited (associated), as stated in the concomitant Membership Regulations.

Full members have the right to hold their membership in two countries. The full membership gives a voting right at Congresses and Working meetings. In any given country / region (in countries with a federation or similar government) there can be only one full WCHSA member at a given time in every main field of activity (i.e. breeding, hunting, sports, etc.).

The limited member is allowed to host only National level events. It does not get a voting right at Congresses and Working meetings but has to be represented in all WCHSA commissions. In any given country / region there may be a limited number of associated members in every main field of activity, with the approval of the full member in the same field, but WCHSA strives for unity and growth of the organizations.

II. CONTACT INFORMATION OF THE NEW MEMBER AND ACTIVITIES DISCLAIMER

Here and forth the officially registered organization called NEW MEMBER is mentioned in its role of an organization with a (national, regional, local) level of activity with (noncommercial, commercial) legal registration, the main interests of which are in the field of (cynology, hunting, sports, etc.)

In the cynology department the NEW MEMBER works in the field of (breeding and exterior, hunting – sports and/or utility, sports with dogs and utility activities with dogs)

The organization declares that its work is done in agreement with the laws of the country of its registration and the international disciplines and rules concerning the cynology and the zootechnics, hunting sports with dogs and the animal welfare as a whole.

The decision to become a member of WCHSA means that the organization accepts the goals and objectives of WCHSA and obliges itself to follow the word and spirit of the rules and regulations of the international alliance, and its representatives and members are informed and understand that the signing of the contract not only obliges the NEW MEMBER to follow the politics of WCHSA and to work according to the rules of the international alliance but also obliges it to take part in the commissions of WCHSA and to actively participate in its management.

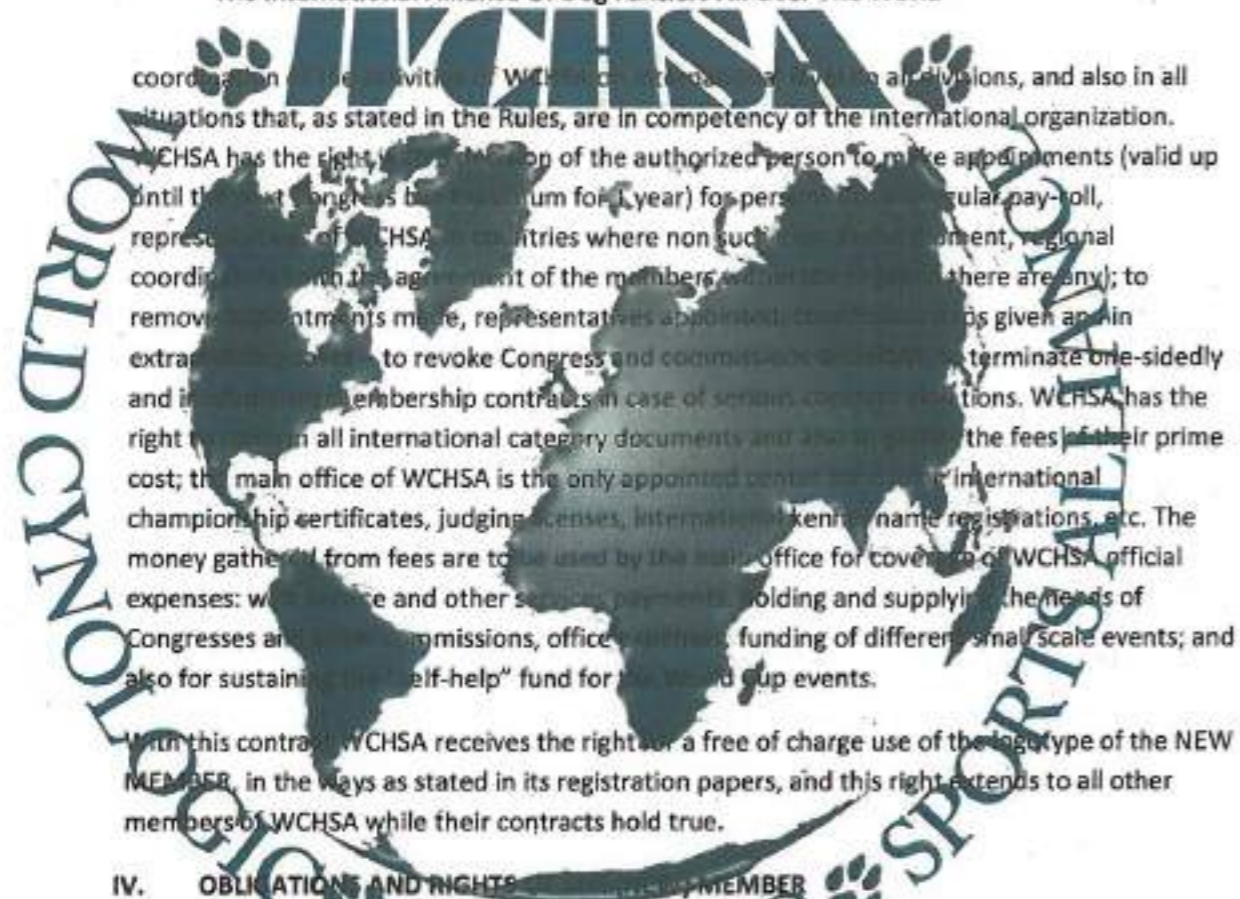

III. OBLIGATIONS AND RIGHTS OF WCHSA

With this contract WCHSA takes the obligations to, on its account: carry out both overall and personal information and publishing services for all members – full and limited; to ensure the year-round function of the main office (excluding 1 month holidays) and to fulfill the contacts between the members and the central office in time and without slowdowns; to coordinate the work of all members in the fields of work concerning the goals and aims of WCHSA in the departments under control of the central office and the other organs of WCHSA; to serve in time and in timely manner the service of the physical persons and the regional offices of all the members (both full and limited); to organize not less than two times early Congresses of WCHSA and on its account to provide the data service and materials for the Congresses; to keep confidentiality concerning the information about WCHSA as whole and its members.

WCHSA has the right to access information connected to the work of the member organizations concerning the effective control and coordination of the European directives and international laws (in particular – animal welfare as whole, the zootechnical parameters of the breeding programs, sports with dogs and practical use of the dogs in hunting) and also control and



coordination with WCHSA in all divisions, and also in all situations that, as stated in the Rules, are in competency of the international organization. WCHSA has the right of nomination of the authorized person to make appointments (valid up until the next Congress but maximum for 1 year) for persons on regular pay-roll, representatives of WCHSA in countries where non such representation, regional coordinators with the agreement of the members (where there are any); to remove appointments made, representatives appointed, commissions given an in extra-ordinary cases to revoke Congress and commissions and terminate one-sidedly and immediately membership contracts in case of serious contraventions. WCHSA has the right to appear in all international category documents and also to collect the fees of their prime cost; the main office of WCHSA is the only appointed center for international championship certificates, judging licenses, international kennel name registrations, etc. The money gathered from fees are to be used by the main office for covering of WCHSA official expenses: wages and other salaries, payments, holding and supplying the needs of Congresses and commissions, office expenses, funding of different small scale events; and also for sustaining a "self-help" fund for the award cup events.

With this contract WCHSA receives the right for a free of charge use of the logo type of the NEW MEMBER, in the ways as stated in its registration papers, and this right extends to all other members of WCHSA while their contracts hold true.

IV. OBLIGATIONS AND RIGHTS OF THE NEW MEMBER

With the signing of the contract the NEW MEMBER obliges, in a period of maximum 3/6/12 months to put its rules, regulations and documentation in conformity with the requirements of WCHSA and after that it is obliged to work in accordance to the rules and regulations of the organization. The NEW MEMBER is obliged to give to the main office in time all the information required about its work and activities, the past events of national and regional level, past and future events of international level, and also submit in time all kennel name applications, international and multi-championship forms, confirmation forms for judges and trainers categorization, expositions and events calendars. The NEW MEMBER is also obliged to keep active at least one web-based service (web-site, Facebook page or account, other) about the organization and one e-mail account. It is obliged also to keep confidentiality concerning the internal information about WCHSA and the other members; to assure full assistance for fulfillment of activities and reaching the goals of WCHSA and to fulfill the decisions of the Congresses, the meetings, the regional coordinator, the commissions and the other authorized organs and persons; to give to WCHSA all the information needed for the normal functions of the main office. The NEW MEMBER is obliged to recognize the breed standards, documents

(pedigree, certificates, etc.) titles and the trainers of all the other members of WCHSA.

The NEW MEMBER has the right to full access to all the information on all levels concerning the work of the central office; the right to in-time service and international service; the right to participate in the management of WCHSA; the right to elect and remove its own representatives; the right to use the web-service of WCHSA; the right to the management of all its events of international level free of charge; the right to use all the facilities provided by sponsors of WCHSA that are available for its country; also the right to the publication of all its documents, titles and medals of its organization by all members and coordinators of WCHSA. The NEW MEMBER has the right of free of charge consultations and help in the main office, regional coordinators and members of the commissions of WCHSA, and prior participation of members of the organization in courses, seminars and other events for qualification, organized by WCHSA by a minimum of charge, the members of the organization are also to use discounts that member of WCHSA may use.

The NEW MEMBER has the right, while its country stands true, to use the logotype of WCHSA free of charge as described, and also when needed to use the logotypes of all other members of WCHSA.

V. FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

As per decision of WCHSA Congress from 2018, since 01.01.2019 the following financial obligations are in effect:

- 50 Euro per year to the web-hosting and design of the website of WCHSA
- 20 Euro per each International dog show (CACIB) to the expenses of the central office.
- 50 Euro license per year for all International judges
- 35 Euro for international registration of a Kennel name
- 15 Euro price for an International champion, Multichampion, Grand International and Grand Multichampion certificates (which are to be issued by the central office only)

Also at the Congress 2019 it was decided that:

- When holding a championship of another country, the organizing organization is to keep 100% of the champion certificates exchange price.
- Each International rank expert is to receive "souvenir money" per each show judges amounting to 50 Euro and has no right to ask for a bigger amount; the inviting organization is obligated to take care of all the expenses of the judge in connection with

travel tickets, food and drinks, an appropriate housing and 3 meals a day during the visitation.

VI. MEMBERSHIP TERMINATION

WCHSA membership may be terminated in case if, as stated in the Rules, there are:

- Serious malpractices of the existing law system of the country of registration
- Serious systematic malpractices of the Rules or Regulations of WCHSA, or the decisions of the executive organs.
- Inflicting moral or material damages to WCHSA or its members
- Long period without contact with the member (more than 12 months)
- Simultaneous membership in another system / unauthorized partnership with another international organization

VII. TERMS AND DURATION CLAUSES

This contract takes effect immediately after it is signed and is in power for the term of:

- A. 1 (one) year if the NEW MEMBER enters the WCHSA for the first time. The NEW MEMBER has the right to attain only a LIMITED MEMBERSHIP. After the contract term is over, the possibility of continuing the contract or attaining full membership (if such exists) must be discussed at the nearest Congress.
- B. years and the NEW MEMBER attains for this period the status of a LIMITED MEMBER which may be, during this term if such a possibility exist, put for re-voting on a Congress, if the NEW MEMBER wants it.
- C. 5 years and the NEW MEMBER attains for this period the status of a FULL MEMBER. In case of malpractice stated in its work, the regional coordinator or the main office staff may put on a Congress of WCHSA the question of lowering the membership to LIMITED.**

Termination of the contract may be made by:

- A. Mutual agreement. The NEW MEMBER states decision to leave WCHSA at a Congress or Working meeting.
- B. Unilaterally. The NEW MEMBER announces in written form to WCHSA (the main office) its decision to terminate the contract or, after a proposal stated from the main office is seen at a Congress/Working meeting, the main office announces in written form to the member to inform it about the termination.

In both cases the member is obliged in 1 month to stop using the logotype of WCHSA and the unified documents of WCHSA; the holding of events under the aegis of WCHSA is



for which a decision has been reached. The decision is final and cannot be appealed. WCHSA from its side must remove from its web-services the information about the former member and stop using its logo.

c. The termination of the contract is immediate and the organization is forced immediately to stop using the logo of WCHSA and all other documents of WCHSA, it is forbidden to hold any events under the auspices of WCHSA. The organization has to its exposure all the legal rights to announce the news about the organization's communication.

VIII. MISCELLANEOUS QUESTIONS AND LAW

All litigation questions about this contract should be decided by the way of negotiations between the Sides. If it is not possible to reach agreement the disputes should be decided in court as stated by the laws of R. Bulgaria where WCHSA is registered and where is its juridical address.

The contract in question had been made in two identical copies, both having the same juridical power – one for each Sides.
